Answer all essay questions in the space provided.

1. Grade Point Average \_\_\_\_\_ (To be multiplied by 6 for total points)
2. ACT Score \_\_\_\_\_ (OR) SAT score multiplied by **.045** \_\_\_\_\_ Use highest score but not both.
3. Work Experience: (Judge's discretion based on job requirements, educational opportunities and responsibility. i.e. mowing lawns to assistant manager of retail store. 1-10 points)
4. Did you receive marketing credit for work experience? Yes \_\_\_ No\_\_\_ (5 points for Yes)
5. DECA offices or positions held: Example: chapter Treasurer, and President = 2 offices X 4 points = 8 total points.
6. DECA Competition Accomplishments: (Number of times district qualifier, etc., times point value. Example: district qualifier for two years - 2 X 2 = 4 points.)
7. Activities and accomplishments other than DECA: (Judge's discretion 1-10 points)
8. What Institution of higher learning would you like to attend and why? (Judge's discretion based on academic degree level and students rational.) ( Primarily for information, and to determine student goals) 1-4 points
9. Reflecting on your favorite teachers: What were their outstanding characteristics? (Judge's discretion. Consider such things as student's observation and analysis skills. Also good information for teachers as to characteristics they may want to develop. 1-10 points)
10. What do you consider to be your outstanding characteristics? (Judge's discretion. Consider such things as student's introspection and self analysis skills. 1-20 points)
11. What effect would receiving this scholarship have on your life? (Judge's discretion. Question should help to determine student needs and goals. 1-20 points)
12. How would you like to contribute to society as a result of furthering your education? (Judge's discretion. Answer should reflect on student's goals and values. 1-20 points)
13. Spelling, Grammar, and Writing Skills (Judge's discretion. 1 to 10 Points)
14. Minus 10 points for identifying themselves, their school or their marketing Education Teacher by name. (Ability to follow instructions. Failure to do so is minus 10 points)
